OMNITEK ENTERS INTO CONTRACT WITH LARGE CHINESE ENGINE MANUFACTURER TO DEVELOP ENGINE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Omnitek Engineering, Corp., has entered into a contract with one of the largest engine manufacturers in China, to develop the engine management system for a new engine, which will be used in transit and city bus applications, as well as in heavy-duty trucks.

Under new regulations, no diesel powered truck or bus is allowed to enter the inner city of most large cities in China. Omnitek will develop a closed-loop electronic fuel injection/engine management system for the new gasoline powered engine to comply with EU2 emission standards.

This will be the only gasoline-powered engine for this kind of application and will compete against CNG busses at an average savings to the engine manufacturer of \$ 10,000 per engine.
